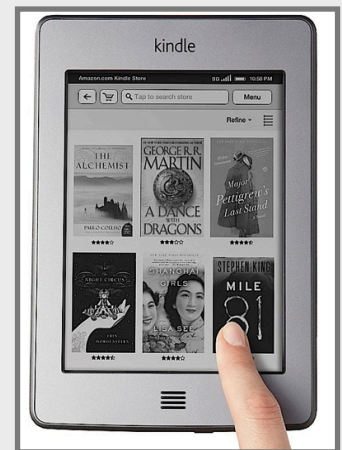
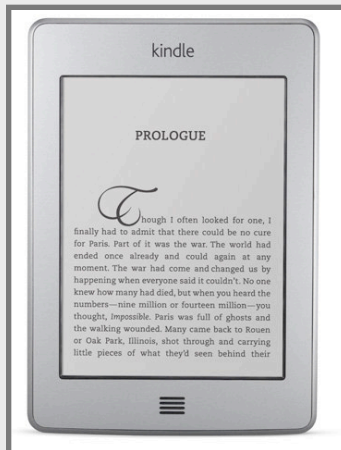


# KINDLE TOUCH

# Pros & Cons

## Pros:

- \* Read in bright sunlight with little glare using e-ink technology.
- \* Adjustable high contrast screen, fonts and font size.
- \* One of the lightest ebook readers around.
- \* Ability to take notes and highlight passages. Can view Amazon.com user's most highlighted passages.
- \* Share passages from your favorite books with family and friends with built-in Twitter and Facebook integration
- \* Lend eligible Kindle books to other Kindle users for 14 days.
- \* Can get 12 free books per year with Amazon.com Prime membership [\$75 for Prime, not all books eligible].
- \* Amazon X-Ray: with a single tap, readers can see all the passages across a book that mention ideas, fictional characters, historical figures, places or topics that interest them.

## Cons:

- \* No manual page turning. Must use touch screen.
- \* Slow/non response to touch can lead to additional touches and then results in multiple page turns.
- \* New technology does not always completely clear out remnants from last page viewed.
- \* When refreshing the page views, it often reorganizes the page layout leaving some confusion as to where you finished reading.
- \* Web surfing, magazine and newspaper viewing is poor.
- \* Side area is too small for bigger fingers to rest on comfortably.
