## What is D&D?

Dungeons and Dragons (often abbreviated to D&D or DnD) is a tabletop RPG (role-playing game) where you play as a made-up character, typically in a fantasy world. You might go on quests, fight hordes of enemies, loot ancient dungeons, or even come face-to-face with a legendary dragon.

Unlike video games, where the world and all of its inhabitants are shown directly on the screen, D&D (along with other tabletop RPG's) utilizes your imagination. You get to explore a world made just for you and your group, while being guided by the DM (Dungeon Master).
